The CEHL Board acknowledges the contribution co-op members do everyday in the work of their co-op and the wider Program.

Those members, who have made an outstanding contribution to the CEHL Co-operative Housing Program are acknowledge by the Board and inducted to the Honour Board according the criteria outlined below.

Nominations are made by co-ops and their members and can be made for previous members including those who have passed away.

HONOUR BOARD CRITERIA

- A minimum of 5 years membership of a CEHL co-operative
- Being of 'good standing' within the nominees co-op; considering, but not limited to, areas such as fulfilment of all active membership requirements, currency of rent payments and maintenance of their property throughout their membership
- Outstanding and sustained contribution to the wider CEHL Program beyond their own co-op, demonstrating their role as a consistently positive and active champion for the CEHL Program and/or the co-op sector
